Parent/Teacher Conference

Policy

Parent/Teacher conferences are scheduled two times a year to discuss child development and educational progress to enhance the knowledge and understanding of both staff and parents. (see Parent and Family Engagement in Education and Child Development Services)

Conducting a Parent/Teacher Conference

Every attempt is made to schedule a conference with the family.

- Classroom Teaching staff schedule Parent/Teacher conferences to take place in the Winter and Spring, to coincide with the collection of the child outcomes data.
 - Classroom Teaching staff make efforts to schedule a conference at times convenient for the parent(s) to attend.
- Parent/Teacher conferences may take place at the center or at other agreed-upon location.
- If person-to-person contact is not possible, a phone conference can be substituted and documented on the Parent/Teacher Conference Form.
- Inca Head Start Parent/Teacher Conference Form
- Classroom Teaching staff complete all items on the Parent/Teacher Conference form during the conference.
- At the end of the conference, both parent and Classroom Teaching staff sign the Parent/Teacher form.
- If a parent declines the Parent/Teacher Conference, the Area Supervisor/FEC signs on the form verifying it was declined.

Documentation/Record Keeping

- Classroom Teachers, enter the date the Parent/Teacher conference was completed, scans and attaches a copy in Child Plus.
- Classroom Teachers, enter the date of attempts to complete Parent/Teacher conference and reason for not completing the conference into Child Plus. Scans and attaches a copy of the form declining the conference, verified by Area Supervisor/FEC into Child Plus.
